ROUTE

FRIDAY 4 MAY: CRIEFF (St Columba's Church) to COMRIE via Knock Mary, Balloch and Turleum Hill to Auchengarrich for a well-earned cuppa (about 8 miles, a gentle climb to Balloch: an alternative route for Three Saints Way



Back from Comrie to Crieff by public bus from Dalginross Stop

SATURDAY 5 MAY: COMRIE (St Serf's Church) to ST FILLAN'S via Maam Road, the White House, secret Loch Baltachan for picnic lunch and down to the Four Seasons for a well-earned beer – or tea! (beautiful, though a bit tougher, some rough walking, quite a long climb at the start, about 8 – 9 miles in all. We will take it leisurely!)

SUNDAY 6 MAY : ST FILLANS (from Four Seasons) to LOCHEARNHEAD



following the old railway line (lovely new cycle track), gentle walking, ending with tea on a friendly host's garden)

MONDAY 7 MAY: LOCHEARNHEAD TO KILLIN

along the railway track via Glenogle then down through Acharn to Killin – ending with celebration tea /barbecue (£5) at St Fillan's Church
