

Information on Croftcarnoch

Croftcarnoch Cottage, Killiecrankie, was gifted to the Diocese of St Andrews, Dunkeld and Dunblane by Bridget Mellor when she died in the 1970s. When Bridget took ownership of the property it consisted of a sitting room, a bedroom and a bathroom and tacked on the end was a further bedroom and a kitchen. During her time of ownership Bridget added to the building which extended the house to create a three bedroomed (sleeps 5) home with a large living room and a spacious kitchen. There is a bathroom, shower room and a WC.

When Bridget left the cottage to the Diocese the stipulation was that it should be used to offer affordable accommodation for clergy to enjoy some rest and relaxation. The Diocese has let the property for clergy retreat and holiday for many years and recently the accommodation has been upgraded and improved to make that retreat and holiday experience a relaxed and comfortable one.
